Exhibitors Guidelines

This year's exhibition will be held in the Springdale Hall Drysdale on Saturday 12th October & Sunday 13th October, 2019 and all BCC members are invited and encouraged to join in with entries of their work.

Opening time for public on the Saturday & Sunday will be 10.00am and last public entry to hall at 4.00pm. Images cannot be removed until 4.00pm Sunday to allow viewing.

Public Choice Display:

- This year there will be a public choice display where the public can vote for their favourite image. The theme will be **"MY FAVORITE IMAGE"** which can be any image of your choice.
- Only 1 entry per member may be submitted with any image size within a standard Mat up to 20" x 16" (50cm x 40 cm). Smaller mats may be used.

Main Display:

- The main hall display will be laid out with an area delegated to each member to display their work with a maximum of 10 prints. Again the standard Mat up to 20" x 16" (50cm x 40 cm) to be used but any size image within the matt. For this area smaller Matts may be used.
- Members name will be displayed above their images and would be good if at some time they would be available to discuss there work, promote the club and talk about their photography.

Larger Images:

- Some members may wish to display additional framed or larger prints. These are to be nominated on the entry form area and will be displayed on a table area on easels.

Sale of Images.

- You may nominate your prints or cards for sale. A commission of 10% of the sale price going to BCC club. Control of image sales, will be managed by BCC Committee members, and members reimbursed for their sales.

EDI Display:

- There will be a separate EDI image presentation of member's works which will comprise of EDI images from this year's competition.

Hall Set/pull down:

- Hall set up will be from 12 midday (6-8 members needed) on Friday 11th October, 2019.
- Erection of images on Friday, will be from 2pm to 4pm, by members on their designated boards.
- Members unable to erect images on Friday should arrange with another member to assist.
- Pull down will commence at 4.00pm on the Sunday. All available members are requested to help and collect their images. If you are unable to collect images, please organise with another member to do so.

General:

- Curator for the Event will be Lynne Bryant. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask.
- Entry submission forms must be handed to Lynne Bryant by 16.9.19 to allow organisation of display areas.

As this is the one major event for the Bellarine Club year, the committee encourages all members to participate to make this year's exhibition a success.
