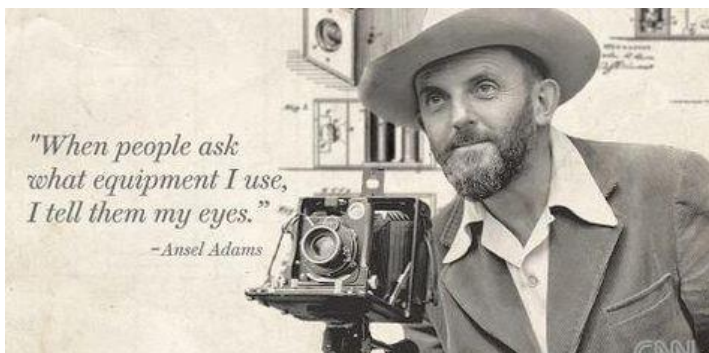

20 locations across Greater Geelong

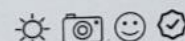
Our popular Giant Selfie Trail is back with some exciting new locations to create precious memories.
